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Objective:

To assess the impact of a Perinatal Palliative Care (PPC) Program on pregnant women and families with a prenatal diagnosis of lifelimiting fetal conditions.



Retrospective study 2008-2022 Fetuses life-limiting fetal conditions

√ Trisomy 21
√ Bilateral renal agenesis
√ Acrania-anencephaly

<u>Enhanced holistic care</u>: interdisciplinary approach, skin-to-skin contact, bereavement support, memory-making, and attention to spiritual, psychological, and social needs (from <10% to 90–100%).
